More news to follow.

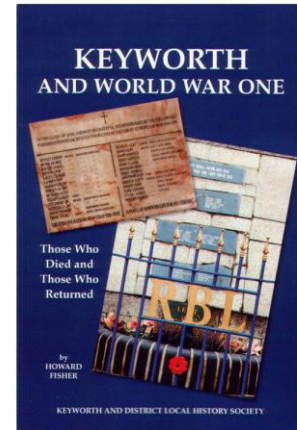

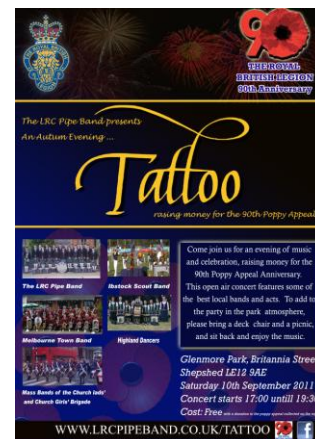
