

OUR CARE

At Maurice House, our trained staff care for each resident as a unique individual. Everyone is treated with respect, dignity and freedom of choice, in a safe, well-equipped environment which feels like home.

Every resident has a care plan to ensure that all their care needs are met. All residents will also have a named nurse and/or keyworker. Our staff specialise in a model of dementia care based on the Butterfly Household Model.

There are three wings of 10 en-suite bedrooms leading to a central hub area. Each wing has its own lounge, dining room and bathroom. The central hub has a café, hairdresser and activity area. It's a secure environment, and residents living with dementia can walk freely and safely around the house and our two gardens.



OUR ACTIVITIES

Activities run seven days a week and include exercise classes, arts and crafts, flower arranging, bingo, film and computer clubs. There are weekly days out, shopping trips and regular visits from musicians.

Residents who enjoy gardening can continue their hobby in our greenhouse or by tending our raised flowerbeds. Those who are not able to join the regular shopping trips can make use of a weekly mobile shop and library. A hairdresser also visits our home every week.

DUNKIRK MEMORIAL HOUSE
Situated close to the village of Bishops Lydeard, eight miles from the bustling town of Taunton, Somerset.

GALANOS HOUSE
Located on the edge of Southam, a small market town in the Warwickshire countryside.

HALSEY HOUSE
Set in Cromer, an attractive town on the North Norfolk coast.

LISTER HOUSE
Situated in the picturesque town of Ripon in the Yorkshire Dales.

MAIS HOUSE
Located in a quiet cul-de-sac in the coastal town of Bexhill-on-Sea, East Sussex.

WHO CAN STAY?

The Royal British Legion has six care homes which provide short and long-term care for serving and ex-Service people and their dependants. Situated around the country, they offer a wide range of services including four with specialist dementia care.

Each home is registered with the Care Quality Commission, and has a Statement of Purpose and Resident Guide (available on request) which clearly define the care and services provided.

Our care home communities include men and women of varied ages and abilities. Our homes are exclusive to ex-Service people and their dependants, so there is always a special camaraderie.

OUR LOCATION

Maurice House is situated outside the coastal town of Broadstairs, Kent and enjoys picturesque coastal views of Joss Bay and the North Foreland lighthouse. Residents can visit the Charles Dickens Museum and Bleak House where he wrote 'David Copperfield'.
